This traditional Miner's Gala occurs in the second Saturday of September and takes Snibston back to its colliery roots. The event kicks off with a procession round Coalville town centre and carries on to Snibston Discovery Museum with a fruit, flower and vegetable show, local history displays, mining memorabilia and colliery tours.
